
Revealed in Mak-ka, 11 Verses

In the Name of Allaah, the All-Compassionate, the Most Merciful.

- 1. Al-qaa-ri-'ah The Clatterer,
- 2. <u>Mal-gaa-ri-'ah</u> –What is the clatterer?
- 3. <u>Wa maa-ad-raa-ka mal-qaa-ri-'ah</u> And what shall make you understand what the clatterer is?
- 4. <u>Yau-ma ya-koo-nun-naa-su-kal-fa-ra-shil-mab-soos</u>— (It is) a day when men shall be like (countless and uneasy) scattered flying-worms,
- 5. <u>Wa ta-koo-nul ji-baa-lu kal-'ih-nil-man-foosh</u> and the mountains shall be like dyed carded wool.

This refers to the last Day of this world's Dooms, when every thing shall perish and all mankind shall rise after their death and gather in the Vast Plain, for the Measure of good and evil and for the final Awards.

- 6. <u>Fa-am-maa man sa-qu-lat ma-waa-zee-nu-hoo</u> Then he whose scales (of good-deeds) weigh heavy, (in the Balance) -
- 7. <u>Fa-hu-wafee'ee-sha-tir-raa-zhi-yah</u> –hence he shall be in a life, well pleasing.
- 8. <u>Wa am-maa-man khaf-fat ma-waa-zee-nu-h</u>oo But he whose scales (of good deeds) weigh light, (in the Balance) –



That day Man shall be as helpless as an infant in mother's womb; similarly he will be locked up in Hell.

- 10. <u>Wa-maa ad-raa-ka maa hi-yah</u> and what shall make you understand what is it?
- 11. <u>Naa-run haa-mi-yah</u> It is a Fire, blazing.
