

SOO-RA-TUL-LAIL

Chapter 92 Revealed at Mak-ka, 21 Verses

In the Name of Allaah, the All-Compassionate, the Most Merciful.

- 1. <u>Wal-lai-li i-zaayagh-shaa</u> By the night when it covers (with darkness),
- 2. Wan-na-haa-ri i-za ta-jal-laa by the day when it (fully) lights up,
- 3. Wa maa kh-la-qaz za-ka-ra wal un-saa and that (from which) He created the male and the female,
- 4. <u>In-na-sa'-ya-kum la-shat-taa</u> surely, (the results of) your efforts are different.
- 5. <u>Fa-am-maa man a'-taa wat-ta-qaa</u> So who gives (in the way of Allaah) and abstains (from evils) and follows the path of righteousness),
- 6. <u>Wa sad-da-qa bil hus-naa</u> and testifies (by thought, speech, deeds and actions) the virtue (of the Faith and its reward),
- 7. <u>Fa-sa-nu-yas-si-ru-hoolil-yus-raa</u>— so we will facilitate (for) him (the way to) comfort and Bliss.
- 8. <u>Wa am-maa man ba-khi-la was-tagh-naa</u>— But who acted niggardly (as a miser) and (deemed himself) self-sufficient (i.e. disregarded Allaah, His Teachings and Rewards),
- 9. <u>Wa kaz-za-ba bilhus-naa</u>— and denied virtue (the truth of the tenets and principles of Islam),



- 10. <u>Fa-sa-nu-yas-si-ru-hoo lil-'us-raa</u> so We will facilitate for him (the path) to Adversity (and Torment) i.e., he will gradually leave all capacity to do virtues and of firmly believing in the eternal Truth, and thus lead himself to the wrong path and wrong goal;
- 11. <u>Wa maa yugh-nee-'an-hoo maa lu-hoo i-zaa ta-rad-daa</u> and his wealth shall not avail him, when he perishes.
- 12. <u>In-na-'a-lai-naa lal-hu-daa</u> Surely, on Us, rests the direction (to explain and differentiate the right and the wrong paths).
- 13. Wa in-na la-naa lal aa-khi-ra-ta wal-oo-laa And on Us is the hereafter and the first (this world) i.e., the creation, the possession, and the Awards and the Rewards.
- 14. <u>Fa-an-zar-tu-kum naa-ran ta-laz-zaa</u>— Therefore, I warn you of a blazing Fire:
- 15. <u>Laa yas-laa-haa il-lal-ash-qa</u> which none shall enter therein except the most wretched —
- 16. <u>Al-la-zee kaz-za-ba wa ta-wal-laa</u> who rejected (the truth) and turned back i.e., who denied prophethood and the Book, persisted in disbelieving and turned away from the Faith and the Teachings.
- 17. <u>Wa sa-yu-jan-na-bu-hal-at-qa</u> But will be saved, far from it (Hell) those most-fearing (Allaah),
- 18. <u>Al-la-zee yu-tee maa la-hoo ya-ta-zak-kaa</u>, who gives away his wealth to (fully) purify himself.

It is stated that the Verse No. 15 pertained to Umayya bin Khalf (who had enslaved Hazrat Billal, *Razhi-Yallahu 'Anhu*). The Verse No. 17 appeared for Hazrat Abu Bakr Siddique, (*Razhi-Yallahu-'Anhu*) who freed Hazrat Billal, *Razhi-Yallahu-'Anhu*, in exchange of no favour bestowed on him. The Verses also serve as examples for universal application for all time to come.



- 19. <u>Wa maa li-a-ha-din 'in-da-hoo min-ni'-ma-tin tuj-zaa</u> and (it was) for nobody's favour on him, which was to be repaid -
- 20. <u>Il-lab-ti-ghaa-'a waj-hi Rab-bi-hil a'-laa</u> except to seek the Face (Pleasure) of his Almighty-Lord, the Most High;
- 21. <u>Wa la-sau-fa yar-zhaa</u> and he shall soon be (fully) pleased (with the Divine Bliss and Kindness).
